A Message from Administration

Dear parents/guardians,

Preparing for Testing– Testing Season has started. Our identified English Language Learners in grades K-5 will take the WIDA assessment this month. This assessment measures English proficiency in reading, writing, speaking, and listening.

Second grade students just finished being tested for the Gifted and Talented Education (G.A.T.E.) program. If selected, students will receive pull out services with a G.A.T.E. specialist, starting in third grade.

Students in grades 3-5 will take the Smarter Balanced Assessment in March and April to assess English Language Arts (reading and writing) and Mathematics. CCSD is in the second year to administer the Smarter Balanced Assessment, an online assessment that replaces the former CRT state-wide test. Results are used to determine students' academic growth over time and are used in determining our school's rating. Students in grade 5 will also take the Science Assessment. Marion Earl ES will host a Parent Testing Meeting on February 15, 2019 at 3:30 p.m. Come to learn more about Smarter Balanced. All parents are welcomed.

How can you help prepare your child? The easiest way to help your child succeed is to ensure your child gets a good night's sleep and eats breakfast. Rather than being sleepy and hungry, your child will be awake and focused. If your child is in grades 3-5 you can have him/her practice online at the Smarter Balanced website (<https://wbte.drctdirect.com/NV/portals/nv/>). I urge you to take this assessment online yourself. This will help you see what is expected of your child.
