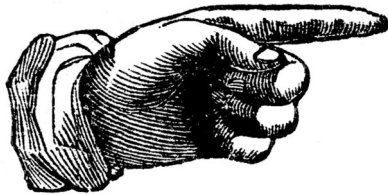


A Message from Administration
